Early Childhood Day Treatment (ECDT)	Pre-K-2 nd K-2 nd full day	8:30-11:00 12:45-3:15 8:15-3:15	Treatment groups for children with a mental health diagnosis that display emotional or behavioral challenges. Full day students also receive education.
Day Treatment	2 nd -11 th full day 3 rd -5 th half day 5 th -6 th half day	9:10-3:00 9:00-11:45 12:30-3:15	Treatment groups for students with a mental health diagnosis that display emotional or behavioral challenges. Full day students also receive education across three divisions (elementary, middle, and high school).
Education Based Programs	Grades	Hours	Services Provided
Lower School Integrated Therapeutic Classroom (ITC)	K-3 rd 4-6 th	7:40-2:00	Students experience therapeutic day treatment integrated within the academic classroom.
Lower School	K-8 th	7:40-2:00	A therapeutic school designed for students with behavioral and learning challenges.
Upper School	7 th -12 th	7:40-2:00	A therapeutic school designed for students with behavioral and learning challenges.
Upper School Virtual Classroom	9 th -12 th	7:40-2:00	Students earn the credits they are lacking for graduation due to academic and behavioral challenges.
After School Virtual Classroom	9 th -12 th	2:30-5:00	Students have the opportunity for credit recovery in an after-school classroom setting as an alternative to home instruction.
Heidt Center of Excellence/ Autism Services Programs Main Number: 513-527-7262	6 th -12 th G23/Transition	8:00-3:00 {dependent on classroom placement}	An accredited alternative educational program for students with autism and related disorders, offering credit towards a high school diploma, transition programming for students who have continued their education beyond their senior year, summer program options, and vocational services for students qualifying for services via Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities.

Students who demonstrate the following may not benefit from Campus Based Programs

IQ below 70 {other than Autism Services}

Active substance abuse

Sexualized behaviors

Actively psychotic, suicidal, or homicidal

Weapons charges or history of weapons use

Untreated contagious medical conditions

Unsuccessful discharge from The Children's Home within 2 years

An Individualized Education Plan (IEP) is required for enrollment in the Full Day Treatment Program and all Education Based programs.
